The weather is perfect for those nightly strolls, patio dining and activities of all kinds.

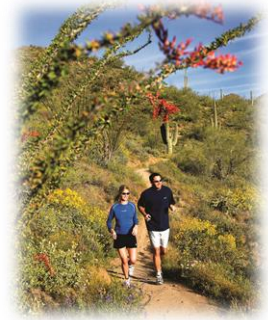

Things to Bring along

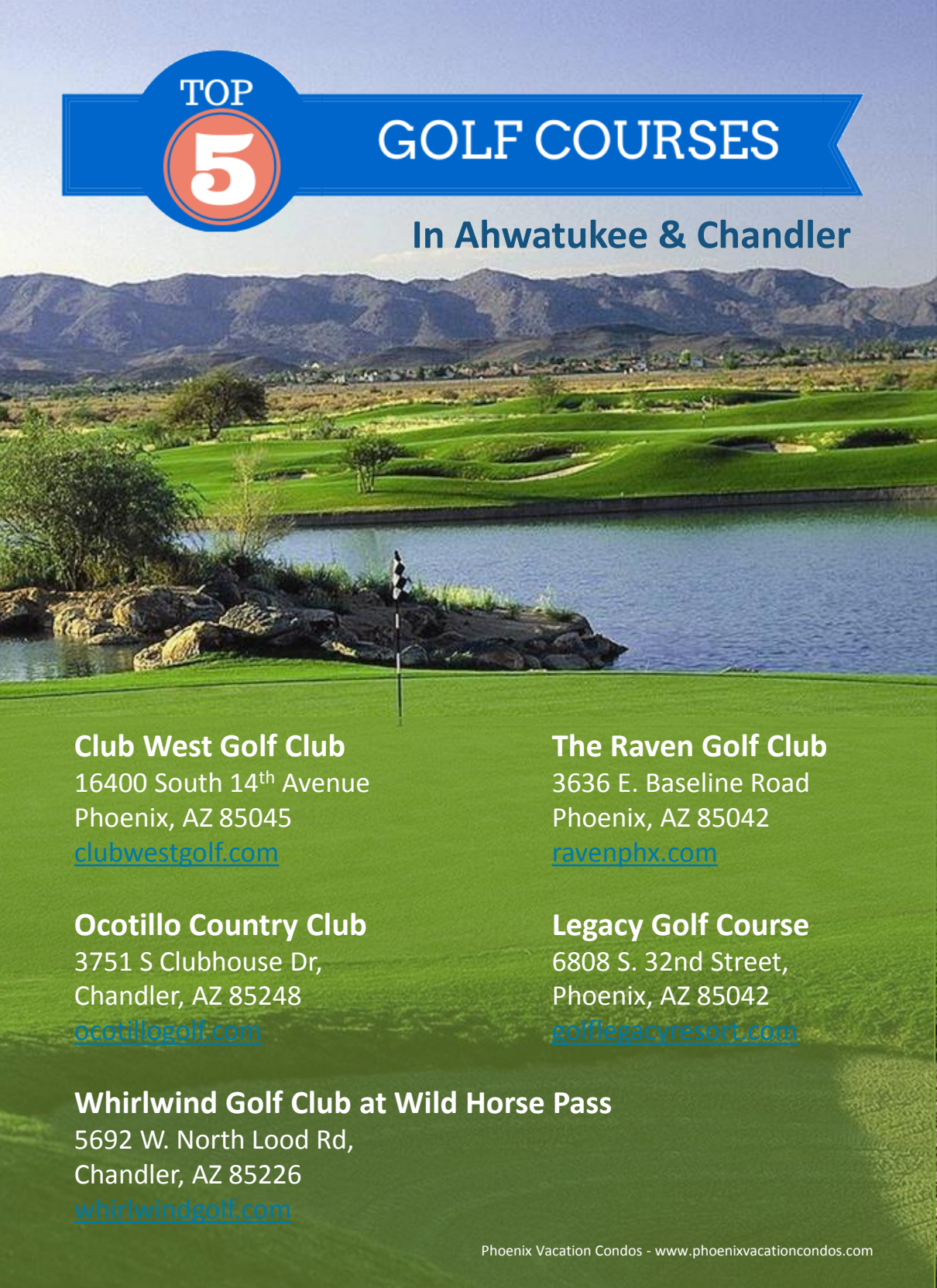
